

Local Law No. 2 of the year 2017

Village of East Nassau, County of Rensselaer

A local law repealing the authorization to impose a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to repeal Local Law No. 1 of the year 2017 which authorized the adoption of a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2017, that includes a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c and to thus reinstate the limits on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Village of East Nassau as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Effect

This Local Law hereby repeals in its entirety said Local Law Number 1 of 2017, and declares the same of no force or effect, and thus reinstates the tax levy limits imposed by General Municipal Law §3-C for the fiscal year beginning on June 1, 2017.

Section 3. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 4. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
