

Introductory Local Law No. 2 of the year 2013

Village of East Nassau, County of Rensselaer

A local law establishing a 30 mph speed limit on Dunham Hollow Road/County Route 66 in the Village of East Nassau

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to authorize a speed limit to be established for Dunham Hollow Road (a.k.a. County Route 21) within the municipal boundaries of the Village of East Nassau as no speed limit is now posted on said road within the Village and, as such, to further the policy of the Village of East Nassau to improve the safety of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on and along roads, streets and highways within the Village to the maximum extent possible and as allowed by law.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to Article 39, section 1643 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, the Village Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 3. Establishment of Speed Limit

It is hereby established that the maximum speed limit at which any and all vehicles may travel on or along, in either direction, the entirety of that portion of Dunham Hollow Road/County Route 21 situate within the municipal boundaries of the Village of East Nassau is thirty (30) miles per hour.

Section 4. Posting and Enforcement

Upon the effective date of this law, the speed limit established by this law for the aforesaid highway within the Village shall be posted with said established speed limit and enforced by the appropriate law enforcement agencies and officers as any other speed limit maximum.

Section 5. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
